- Competition: Conventional Pistol Outdoor - 900
- Range: 50 yards Slow Fire (Weather Permitting) – 25 yards Timed & Rapid Fire
52 Covered Firing Ports - Bring Your Own Snowshoes.
- Eligibility: Membership in the NRA is not required. This is an NRA Approved Event

- Fee Is \$10.00 for the 900 - Register by email. Pay at the match.
- Start Time: 9:00 A.M. Registration-Shooting starts at 10:00.
- Rules: Current NRA rules will govern. An Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required to indicate the slide is open and the chamber is empty.
- Classification: Competitors must show a valid current outdoor classification or score record book. All unclassified competitors must shoot in the Master Class.
- Firearms: Competitors may use .22, centerfire, or .45 pistols as per NRA rules for Conventional Pistol. Triggers may be weighed. If National Records are broken; triggers *will* be weighed.
- Targets: All Slow Fire will be on NRA B-6 50 yard slow fire target. All Timed and Rapid Fire will be on the NRA B-8 25 yard timed & rapid target. Targets and repair centers will be provided. 52 ports available.
- Scoring: Competitors will pass score cards to the right. Plugs and/or gauges will be used only by designated range personnel. A \$2.00 Challenge fee will be charged for each scoring challenge. The Official Match Referee(s) will rule on challenges. Competitors are responsible for repairing their own targets; bring your own stapler, pen and a small clipboard. Felt tipped pens are not allowed. You will be yelled at by our scorer.
- Awards: Bragging rights as the winner of the first match of 2012
- Match 1 Slow Fire, 20 Shots
Match 2 National Match Course, 30 Shots
Match 3 Timed Fire, 20 Shots
Match 4 Rapid Fire, 20 Shots
