Total \$85 per shooter for all matches

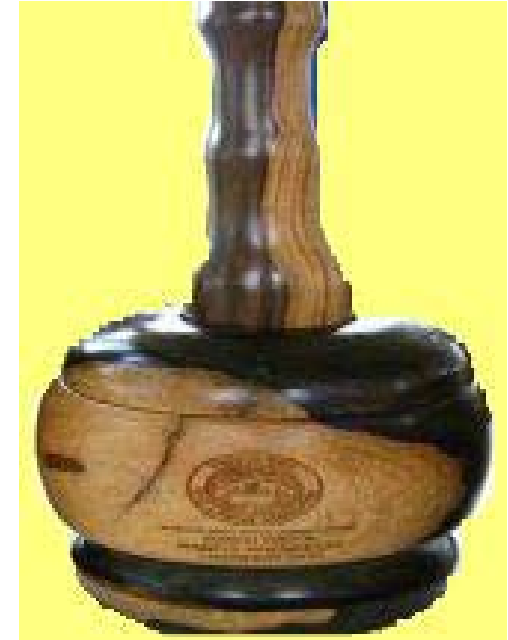
NRA and CMP Rules will Govern

A medal will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each class. In Team Matches a plaque will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, plus medals for each of the team shooters.

Complimentary food and beverages will be served during award ceremony, usually Roasted Pork with traditional sidings.

Getting here, cost of lodging etc..

Direct flights to San Juan are easy to find from mayor Hubs like Atlanta, Miami, Dallas, NY, Newark, DC and LA. (Expect to pay close to \$500 round trip)

Salinas is located in the South east of the Island, approximately an hour and fifteen minutes away from San Juan and forty five minutes away from Ponce. (second largest city).

Although Salinas is a small town, there are plenty of affordable places in which you can stay, with great fresh seafood and clean accommodations. Military personnel including retired servicemen with a valid Military I.D. card, can stay on base for free. The base offer Barracks equipped with air conditioners and bathrooms. Each barrack will hold approximately 6 to 8 shooters. (Military facilities, do not expect Hotel grade facilities)

Travelling with Firearms: Flying to Puerto Rico with firearms is the same as flying to any other State, you register at the airline counter (Check airline regulations first), and then you complete and sign the UNLOADED FIREARMS CARD. TSA may check your luggage prior departing.

However, in order to participate in the Tournament you need a provisional firearms license, it won't cost you anything and I will take care of all the paperwork on your behalf. Those committed to participating in the Match, should communicate via e-mail and I will forward the Official PRPD Form.
