HOSTED BY: Los Angeles Rifle & Revolver Club.

LOCATION: The Los Angeles Rifle and Revolver Club is located on Loma Ave inside the Whittier Narrows Recreation Area in South El Monte, approximately 12 miles east of Los Angeles. Take Rosemead boulevard (State Route 19) south from I-10 or north from I-60 to the Whittier Narrows recreation area. The park entrance will be on the East side; after entering the park, turn right at the first stop sign, then follow the road as it circles the soccer fields to another stop sign at Loma Ave. Turn left (south) and the range will be on the right, between the BMX bicycle race track and the model airplane field.

ELIGIBILITY: To members and non-members of the NRA. Must be a member of the NRA to establish a National Record.

NRA RULES: Will govern the tournament. "OPEN Bolt Indicators" are required. Due to the strict safety regulations of this range, **ALL** competitors must be sighted in and able to keep all shots in the black. Eye and ear protection are required.

ADVANCED ENTRY: Send SR-1 card, plus entry fees to Ray Del Rio, 5981 Hadrians Cres. Anaheim, CA 92807. Phone (714) 612-4585. SR-1 card will be accepted at the range before the competitors' fire. Do not mail entry fees with less than 5 business days before the match.

ENTRY FEES: \$40.00 for both days, \$20.00 for one day. All Junior club members' fees are half the adult fees. NRA registration and cost of targets is included. Entry fee will be refunded if competitor is unable to attend the tournament. Make checks payable to **LAR&R CLUB.**

ENTRY LIMITS: We are limited to 40 firing points. Walk on entries may be accepted to capacity of the range.

TOURNAMENT RESULTS: Results will be posted on the club's website www.larrclub.org competitors who request a paper results bulletin may have one mailed to them.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA Classification will be used. Competitors will use their assigned classification. Those without a current NRA Smallbore classification may: (1) Use a temporary score book or (2) Compete in the Master classification; (NRA Rule 19.8) A competitor may shoot in a higher class.

CHALLENGE FEES: \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge of your own match score. \$3.00 for another competitors' match score. Fee returned for sustained challenges (NRA rule 16). Challenge slips provided at the STAT office.

TARGETS: NRA Meter targets, A-50, and A-33 will be used. Bring your own binder clips (approximately 8-12). Competitors hang their own target and retrieve the target to their right. Competitors may not handle their own fired targets anywhere at any time. **DO NOT SCORE YOUR TARGETS**, the STAT office will do that. No one except STAT workers are allowed in the scoring room.

CLUB AWARDS: Awards will be given for each match. The winner of match 11 will receive a plaque and his or her name engraved on a perpetual trophy. The match winner will also receive a GOLD medal. The second and third place winners of match 11 will receive SILVER and BRONZE medals respectively. A plaque will also be awarded to the High Woman and High Junior (if more than one). Half of the entry fees will be paid out to the winners of each class.

MATCHES & PRACTICE: All Matches will be squadded. Squadding will be posted on the firing line on Friday before the match. Competitors will fire from the same firing point on both days. The range will be open on Friday morning for practice. A nominal fee of .25 cents is charged for practice targets. Restrooms and water at the range. Bring your own food. The park opens at 6AM

MISCELLANEOUS: Wind flags will be provided. Personal wind flags may be used per NRA rules (up to 24" in front of the firing line)
