

RULES OF MIXED TEAM EVENTS FOR AIR PISTOL AND AIR RIFLE 2019

GENERAL INFORMATION	
1. Disciplines:	Pistol & Rifle
2. Type of Event:	Team
3. Name of Event:	Mixed Team Pistol, Mixed Team Rifle
4. Number of participants in each team:	Two (2) Athletes from each nation (1 man & 1 woman – participants in the individual events). Each nation can enter (two) 2 teams
5. BIB Number in Medal Match Stage:	No BIB Number will be worn at Medal Matches
6. Number of the stages:	4 stages: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Qualification stage • Quarter Final stage • Semi Final stage • Medal Matches
7. Qualification stage:	The allocation of the athletes in qualification stage will be decided by draw. The members of the same team shoot from the neighbouring positions (the women at the left of the man position). The competing teams are positioned side by side.
8. Number of shots in Qualification stage:	Preparation and Sighting time: 10min. 25 shots by each member of the team (total 50 shots) in 30 min.
9. Scoring in Qualification:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pistol: full ring with inner tens (ISSF rules) • Rifle: decimal (ISSF rules)
10. Ranking in Qualification:	The ranking in Qualification stage will be the combined results of the 2 (two) members of the team of each nation (1 man & 1 woman)
11. Tie in Qualification stage:	Tie for any position will be broken as per ISSF rules.
12. Quarter-finals:	<p>The top 8 teams will compete as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1st ranking Team against 8th ranking Team (Pair 1) • 2nd against 7th (Pair 2) • 3rd against 6th (Pair 3) • 4th against 5th (Pair 4) <p>The allocation of the athletes in Quarter-final stages will be decided by draw. The members of the same team shoot from the neighboring positions (the women at the left of the man position).</p> <p>The competing teams are positioned side by side.</p>
13. Number of shots in Quarter-finals:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preparation and Sighting Time: 5 minutes • 15 shots by each member of the team (total 30)

	shots) in 20 min. The winner of each duel will participate in the Semi-final.
14. Scoring in Quarter-finals:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pistol: full ring with inner tens (ISSF rules) • Rifle: decimal (ISSF rules)
15. Tie in Quarter-finals:	Tie for any position will be broken as per ISSF rules.
16. Ranking after Quarter-finals:	The (4) four eliminated teams from the Quarterfinals will be ranked in 5 th to 8 th places according to the results of the Quarterfinals.
17. Semi-finals stage:	<p>The Semi-finals will take place at the Qualification range.</p> <p>The 4 winners from the Quarter-finals will compete as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Winner Pair 1 against Pair 4 • Winner of Pair 2 against Pair 3 <p>The allocation of the athletes in Semi-final stages will be decided by draw. The members of the same team shoot from the neighboring positions (the women at the left of the man position).</p> <p>The competing teams are positioned side by side.</p>
18. Number of shots in Semi-finals:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preparation and Sighting Time: 5 minutes • 15shots by each member of the team (total30 shots) in 20 min. <p>The winner of each duel will participate in the Semi-final.</p> <p>The winner teams of the Semi-finals will qualify for the Gold Medal match.</p> <p>The two teams in 2nd place of the semi-finals will qualify for the Bronze Medal match.</p>
19. Scoring in Semi-finals:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pistol: full ring with inner tens (ISSF rules) • Rifle: decimal (ISSF rules)
20. Tie in Semi-final stage:	Tie for any position will be broken as per ISSF rules.
21. Medal matches:	<p>The Bronze Medal Match will be shot first, followed by the Gold Medal Match.</p> <p>The Medal Matches will take place at the finals range.</p>
22. Scoring in Medal Matches:	<p>Decimal scoring will be used.</p> <p>The team with the highest combined result of the two (2) members (after each shot) wins two (2) points.</p> <p>In case of equal results each team receives one (1)</p>

	<p>point.</p> <p>The first team to reach 16 points or more will be declared the winner and the match will be stopped.</p>
23. Bronze Medal Match:	<p>The two (2) teams from the 2nd place at the semi-finals will take part in the Bronze Medal Match (positions C and D for the team from the 1st semi-final and positions F and G for the team from the 2nd semi-final)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5min. Preparation time and sighting Time • Presentation of Athletes • 50sec. for each shot • Up to 16 points one by one, for each member of the team • After 16 points, the winner team will be declared Bronze Medallist.
24. Change Over Time	<p>After five (5) minutes change over time, the athletes will be called to the line for the gold/silver medal match.</p>
25. Gold/Silver Medal Match:	<p>The two (2) teams from the 1st place at the semi-finals will take part in the Gold/Silver Medal Match (positions C and D for the team from the 1st semi-final and positions F and G for the team from the 2nd semi-final)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5min. Preparation time and sighting Time • Presentation of Athletes • 50sec. for each shot • Up to 16 points, one by one, for each member of the team • After 16 points or more, the winner team will be declared Gold Medallists, the loser team will be declared Silver Medallists.
26. Scoring in Medal Matches:	<p>Decimal scoring will be used.</p> <p>The team with the highest combined result of the two (2) members (after each shot) wins two (2) points.</p> <p>In case of equal results each team receives one (1) point.</p> <p>The first team to reach 16 points or more will be declared the winner and the match will be stopped.</p>
27. Tie in Medal Matches:	<p>In case of a tie (16:16), the teams will continue with one (1) additional shot to decide the tie. If still there is a tie then the teams will continue to shoot in sequence additional shots (shot by shot) until the tie is broken.</p>
28. Type of Targets:	<p>Electronic Targets for Qualification, quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals and Medal Matches.</p>
29. Malfunction:	<p>The ISSF rule will be followed.</p>

30. Penalties:	<p>In case a shot is fired in the qualification round, before the command preparation and sighting time start, a penalty of -2 will be given for the first shot.</p> <p>In finals, any shot taken before any command, will be count as zero.</p> <p>Any others will be decided according to ISSF rules.</p>
31. National identification, dress-code:	<p>The athletes from each nation must have on the uniform:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rifle: The name of the country designated by 3 letters as determined by the IOC on their jacket pocket on the side which is turned to spectators. • Pistol: The name of the country designated by 3 letters as determined by the IOC on the sleeve of the T-shirt/sports jacket on the side which is turned to spectators.
32. Music & noise:	<p>During the Qualification, Quarterfinals, Semi-finals and the Medal Matches music and noise will be allowed, the TD must approve the music program.</p> <p>The noise is recommended during the final</p>
33. Irregular cases:	<p>Any irregular or disputed cases will be decided according to the ISSF rules.</p>
