SCHEDULE:

First Saturday of the month (except July):

Jan 2; Feb 6; Mar 6; Apr 3, May 1; Jun 5; Jul 17; Aug 7; Sep 4; Oct 2; Nov 6; Dec 4

The range is located in West Houston, between Hwy 6 and Beltway 8, just north of I-10: Take N. Eldridge Pkwy exit (Marker No. 753) and go North about 0.5 miles, just over the levee and the bridge, and then a sharp right turn onto the short unpaved road and continue through the gate to the second range (Range 2). It is behind a long wood stockade fence.

RULES:

NRA **APPROVED** matches. Current NRA Smallbore Rules & the Official Match Bulletin will govern.

ELIGIBILITY:

This is an OPEN match with no age restriction. Bayou Rifles membership is not required.

ENTRIES:

Will be conducted at the matches. All shooters must fill out a NRA SR-1 (supplied at the Match). Match directors will keep SR-1 info on file for subsequent matches.

ENTRY FEES:

\$5:00 per Junior - \$10.00 per Adult.

FIRING STARTS:

10:00 AM sharp! Be there at least an hour early for registration, targets, & equipment setup.

CLASSIFICATION:

Juniors (20 & under) & Adults per course of fire. Three shooters shooting the same discipline will constitute a match.

COURSES OF FIRE:

Participants may select one of the following courses of fire (600pt match):

60 Shot Metric 3-P Course – 20 rds each – Prone, Standing, Kneeling- (3) A51 targets.

60 Shot Conventional 3-P Course - 20 rds each – (3) A23 targets.

60 Shot Prone Course – 20 rds each – (3) A23 targets.

Prone courses may also be shot following F-Class rules

Shooting Distance is 50 yards.

TIME LIMITS:

3P Courses – 20 minutes prone, 30 minutes standing, & 30 minutes kneeling.

Prone courses – 20 minutes per target.

F-Class – 20 minutes per target.

AWARDS:

Place awards may be given at the discretion of the Match Director.

SCORING TARGETS:

Scoring method will be determined at the match.

FIREARM:

NRA Rule 3.2 - any smallbore rifle that meets this rule. Metallic sights only, except for those 60 & older, which may use *Any* (3.7c) sights. There will be no sight separation categories.

Prone courses may also be shot following F-Class rules

GENERAL INFO:

Ear & eye protection are required. Bring your own food & water. No potable water is available. A restroom (porta-potty) is available.

If significant rain has fallen in Houston prior to a scheduled match, high water levels may mean the match will be postponed or cancelled. Match Directors will typically send a match reminder within 1 week of schedule matches and to provide updates in case of any schedule changes.
