Smallbore Prone Clinic and Practice Match

Prone Clinic 9 AM to 11AM

The prone clinic begins with a classroom introduction to NRA conventional prone competition, led by NRA instructors and experienced shooters. Topics will include a discussion of rules, match format, scoring, and equipment. The clinic will finish on the range with students receiving assistance getting into the prone position and adjusting their equipment.

Sight-In 11 AM to Noon

Open to all, the sight-in period will give the clinic participants and those shooters who haven't shot for a while a chance to sight in their rifles, at both 50 and 100 yards.

Pot Luck and Swap Meet Noon to 1 PM

Enjoy a pot luck lunch to chat with your fellow shooters, held at the same time as a swap meet where you can trade surplus equipment or buy the piece of shooting gear that you "need".

80 Shot Practice Match 1PM to 3:30 PM

We'll finish with an 80 shot practice match. The first match will be a metallic sight Dewar Match (20 shots at 50 yards and 20 shots at 100 yards) followed by an any-sight Dewar fired in reverse order. Cash prize or TR&R medal to the highest aggregate score.
